Help for Ukrainian refugees

Histon and Impington area now has over 20 households welcoming Ukrainians into their homes. A group (H&I Ukrainian Support Group) has been set up to help hosts and their guests. We are looking for volunteers who might be willing to help occasionally in a variety of ways: Becoming part of a team around a host and their guests, which could include:

- Helping hosts and guests with admin such as filling in forms
- Accompanying guests to interviews, eg to set up a bank account, get benefits etc
- Cooking meals
- Taking the guests out
- Providing hospitality in your own home
- Sharing your knowledge of the local area
- Driving

Other roles

- Organising/facilitating social events for adults and children.
- Cake baking/serving for social events
- Offering conversational English time with guests
- Support with job hunting
- Visiting new families/hosts to fill them in on what to expect, to find out the needs and to provide a welcome from the village.
- Organising summer activities eg driving a mini bus to the beach.

We are also looking for some more people on the organising group looking at all the needs presented and finding ways to meet them. There may also be something you feel you can offer which is not listed here. If so, just get in touch.
