Then you may be the person we are seeking for this role.

You will take responsibility for the development, oversight and delivery of our ministry with children, in the context of the church's wider vision and mission.

Us

Histon Baptist Church is set centrally in the combined villages of Histon and Impington, just north of Cambridge. The church currently has 130 members plus a good number of regular attendees of all ages. We have regular contact with children and their families through our Sunday morning activities and at our weekly toddler group (Ark) and Welcome Café. We collaborate with other local churches to run family focussed activities for the community throughout the year, including a Holiday Club. The church also has links with local schools and other groups for children.

About the job

You will work in close partnership with the church minister as part of the staff team. A key element of the role is building and supporting volunteer teams with the goal of growing children's faith.

The role will have an inward and outward focus, aiming to strengthen and develop our existing church work as well as reaching out into the community to build and nurture relationships and faith engagement with families.

This is a part-time post and the salary figure will be reflective of experience and qualifications.
