As many of you know, we are in the process of looking to employ a part-time Children's Worker for HBC. We received one strong applicant from our recent advert in the local Cambridgeshire area and we will be interviewing them on Monday 24th March. This will be the first part of the interview process, with an interview panel comprising of the Pastor, an Elder, Deacon, those who work with children at HBC and a parent of a child at HBC.
