ECO tips for gardeners Avoid chemicals

When it comes to weedkillers, fertilisers and pest control, choose organic options. Chemicals damage soil health, pollute water sources and harm a whole host of wildlife,



from birds and butterflies to hedgehogs and frogs. Prevention is better than cure. Make efforts to create a balanced ecosystem in your garden, offering food, shelter and plants that attract wildlife throughout the food chain. Birds will eat aphids, amphibians will pick off slugs and hedgehogs will help to keep insect numbers in check. If you end up with an infestation, look to natural remedies like soapy water, garlic spray and beer traps.
