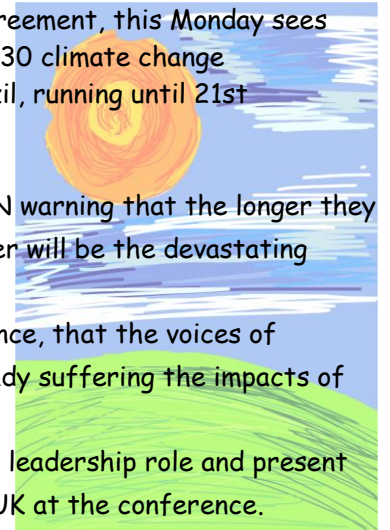


### Doreen's Funeral Service
