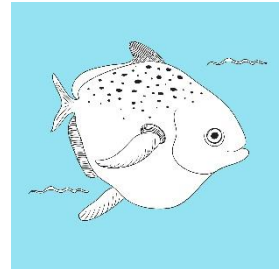

Eco Prayer: On World Oceans Day, June 8th, the UN published the third World Ocean Assessment. This reports that the rate of sea-level rise is double that of a decade earlier, with the world's oceans under severe and accelerating pressure as a result of human activity. As we pray for those responsible for stewardship of God's world, let us thank God for the progress that has been made, whilst we pray for:



- those low-lying nations already experiencing the impact of rises in the sea level - 11% of the world's population live on land that is less than 10m above sea level.
- effective implementation of the landmark high seas treaty, that came into force this year, aiming to protect the two-thirds of the global ocean that lie outside a single country's jurisdiction.
- further international agreements to protect our planet from pollution, deep sea mining and large-scale industrial fishing.
